Roles and Responsibilities

- Share resources with team members towards a collective goal
- Prepare for and participate in monthly meetings
- Allocation of time to meet with or contact donors and/or prospects
- Contribute to grant research and writing (guidance provided)
- Inform best fundraising and development practices
- Assist in developing a long-term fundraising plan and meeting fundraising target goals

In addition to events and fundraising skills, Anduhyaun is looking for a comprehensive spectrum of skills, experience, and thought leadership. The Agency is currently in need of members whose professional background encompasses fundraising, public relations/marketing, grant writing, events management, and/or corporate/stakeholder engagement. Applicants should have knowledge, interest, or experience in supporting the urban Indigenous community, addressing homelessness, ending violence against women, and/or general Indigenous cultural awareness.
